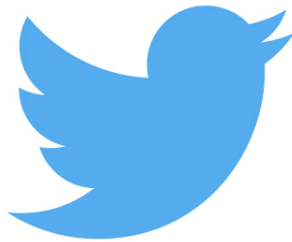
We hope that we can have the opening event on-site at AU. If that is not possible, we will move the event online.
