### Call for Abstracts

The Center for Integrative Business Psychology (CIBP) at Aarhus University will host an interdisciplinary theme day/workshop on Sustainability and Climate Action, June 17, 2022. The focus for this event will be on impact - moving from intention to behavior- and all interested researchers, practitioners from the public and private sectors, funders, and members of the general public are welcome.

We hereby invite submissions of abstracts (300 words) for presentation at the workshop (15 min talk). We welcome theoretical and empirical papers related to sustainability and climate change. Suggestions for topics include (but are not limited to) values and sustainability, behavior and sustainability, decision-making and sustainability, sustainable business and management, public engagement with sustainability, sustainability and leadership, policy and climate action, climate justice, sustainability reporting, sustainability and corporate accountability, sustainability and climate change communication, sustainability and culture.

All speakers are asked to share work they are excited about as well as their biggest topic-relevant questions and challenges.

CIBP is an interdisciplinary center and we welcome submissions from economics, psychology, management, and related fields. Submissions by graduate students, post-docs, and other junior researchers are particularly welcome.
